The Guild

Psychotherapy Clinic

The Guild of Psychotherapists runs a community-based psychotherapy clinic at 47 Nelson Square, Blackfriars Road, London SE1.

The aim of the clinic is to provide psychoanalytic psychotherapy to adults on a low income who live in Southwark, Lambeth and Lewisham.

Staffing

The clinic is staffed by experienced psychotherapists and trainees in supervision.

The Guild is a member of the United Kingdom Council for Psychotherapy.

Fees

The cost of the initial consultation is £25. There is a sliding scale for sessional fees according to income and personal circumstances, with a minimum fee of £5.

Referrals

The clinic accepts enquiries from doctors and other professionals, as well as from patients themselves. However, potential patients are expected to refer themselves to the Clinic directly.

Psychotherapy

Psychotherapy is offered for a range of difficulties.

This might be about something difficult that has happened to you.

It might be that you feel upset, anxious or depressed.

You may be experiencing problems in your relationships with others.

You may want to talk to an independent person about personal matters that you have never been able to discuss before.

You may be experiencing troubling thoughts or feelings.

You may want therapy for yourself to enhance your understanding of yourself.

Length of Psychotherapy

The Clinic offers once weekly psychotherapy for 1 or 2 years.

Confidentiality

The psychotherapy sessions are confidential. But if there is a serious concern that a patient poses a danger to either himself/herself or another person, the psychotherapist may pass on this information to an appropriate professional. This would be with the knowledge of the patient.

Equal Opportunities
